



Oklahoma DeMolay Master Ritualist Program

The Oklahoma DeMolay Ritual Staff is excited to announce the introduction of a new program designed to promote personal ritual growth as well as ritual excellence within Oklahoma DeMolay. The Master Ritualist program will consist of three levels:

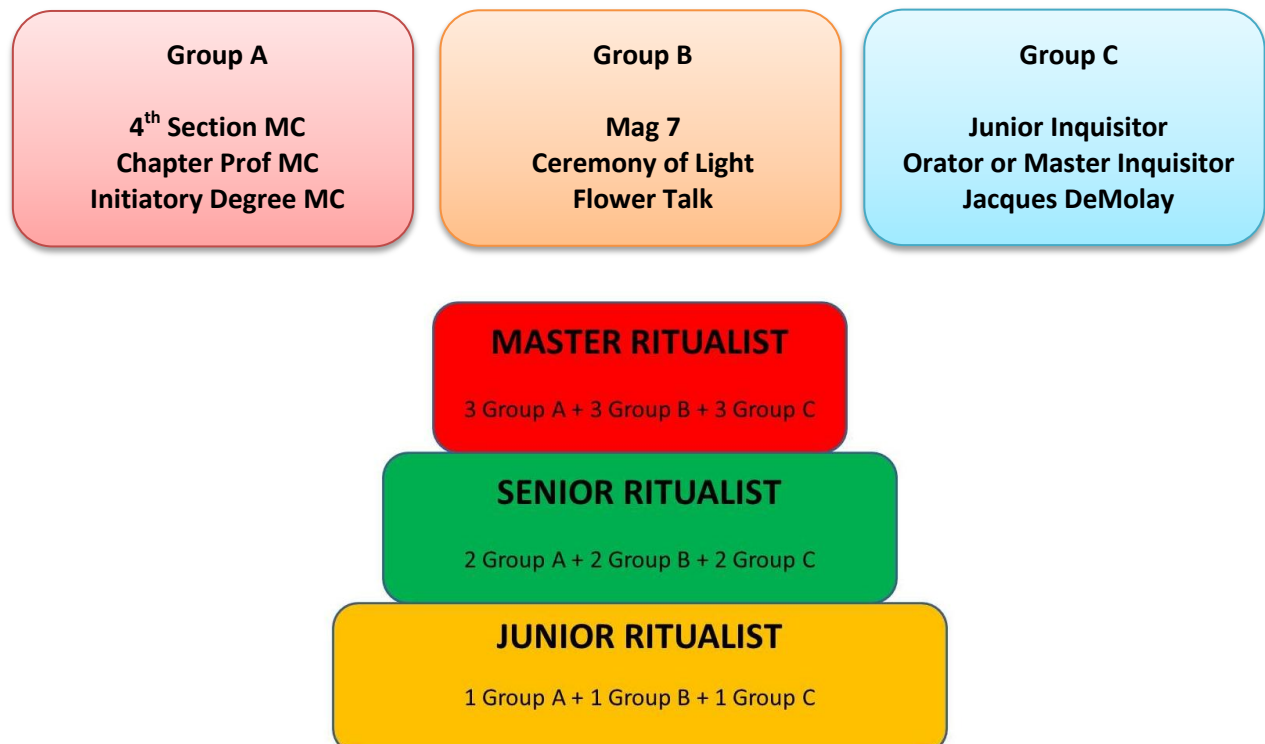
- **Junior Ritualist**
- **Senior Ritualist**
- **Master Ritualist**

An Active DeMolay may attain a level within the MRP by competing in one part from each of the three groups below to proficiency at any sanctioned ritual competition within a single year. A year for the MRP is defined from ODA Conclave to the next ODA Conclave. More than one level may be attained within a single year if so chosen.

Anyone wishing to attempt a level of the MRP must complete the attached form and return to the ODA Director of Ritual at LEAST 14 days prior to the start of Conclave. All DeMolays who achieve a level within the MRP will be honored as such at that year's Conclave awards banquet.

Master Ritualist Program Specifics

1. The Master Ritualist Program is in effect beginning with the 2013 ODA Conclave (July 12).
 - A. The program does not recognize any performances prior to this date as qualification for any of the Master Ritualist levels.
2. The Master Ritualist Program will consist of three, progressive levels. Those levels are:
 - A. Junior Ritualist
 - B. Senior Ritualist
 - C. Master Ritualist
3. The Master Ritualist part groups will consist of the following parts:
 - A. Group A
 - 1) 4th Section MC
 - 2) Chapter Prof MC
 - 3) Initiatory MC
 - B. Group B
 - 1) Magnificent 7
 - 2) Ceremony of Light
 - 3) Flower Talk
 - C. Group C
 - 1) Junior Inquisitor
 - 2) Orator or Master Inquisitor
 - a) Only one of these parts may be chosen to qualify for a MRP level. Once one is chosen, the other one may not be used in any other MRP levels. The choice is up to the entrant.
 - 3) Jacques DeMolay

4. To advance to a higher level within the program, a DeMolay must compete in one part from each of the 3 part groups at an ODA sanctioned ritual tournament within one year. Participant must score at or above the proficiency minimum score as required in the FMCT specifics for that part.
 - A. Examples:
 - 1) 4th Section MC, Mag 7, Junior Inquisitor = Junior Ritualist
 - 2) 4th MC, Flower Talk, Orator, Chap Prof MC, COL, JI = Senior Ritualist
 - 3) All of group A, Group B, and Group C (either Orator or MI) = Master Ritualist
 - B. A year as defined by the MRP is from ODA Conclave to the next ODA Conclave.
 - C. The maximum amount of time allowed to complete a single level is one year, though a level may be completed within a shorter timeframe. A DeMolay may advance through multiple levels within a single year.
 - 1) For example, if a DeMolay takes one year to complete each level, he could attain the level of Master Ritualist within 3 years.
 - 2) It is possible to attain the Master Ritualist level in less than 3 years. For example, a DeMolay could meet the qualifications for both the Junior AND Senior levels in one year by competing in 6 parts within that year. This would allow for the attainment of the Master level within 2 years. The Master level can be attained within one year if all 9 parts are competed in to proficiency within a single year.
 - D. In the event that a MRP entrant is restricted from competing in a given part due to chapter limits or state champion requirements, he will be allowed to perform the given part in front of a panel of qualified judges to satisfy the requirements of the MRP only. This performance would NOT qualify him to receive any other awards for that performance.
 - 1) This provision is only applicable to ritual tournaments managed by the ODA ritual staff. No such panel will exist in any ritual tournament not managed by ODA ritual staff (i.e. Frank Marshall).
5. Any DeMolay interested in attaining one or more levels within the Master Ritualist Program must declare his intent to do so by completing the MRP Registration form at least 14 days prior to each competition.
